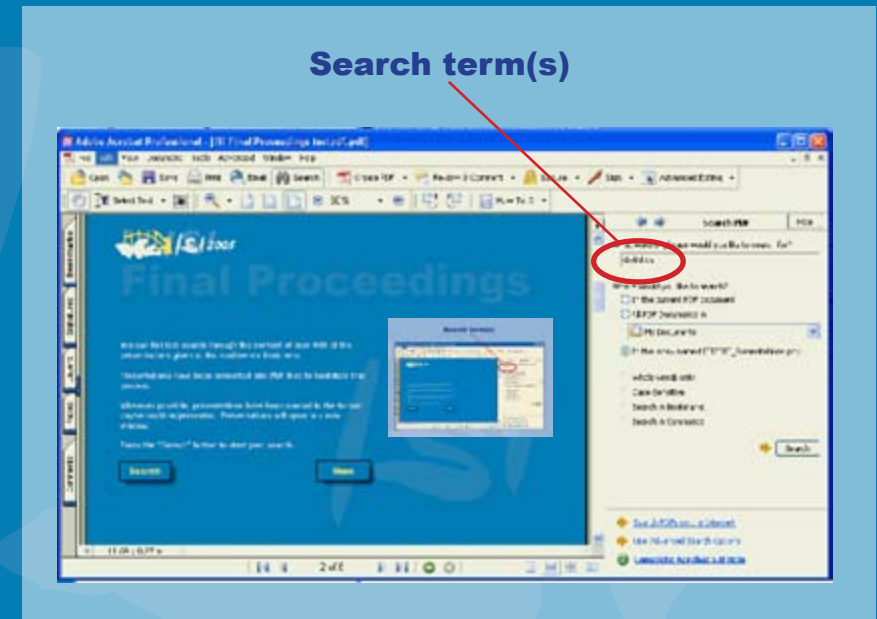
## Search Help
